Late August-September Fertilome Pro Green

Fertilome Pro Green has nitrogen, iron, sulfur and other minor nutrients. Pro Green is perfect for our high alkaline and high pH soils. This is my all time best selling fertilizer. You can use it on the lawn and trees, shrubs, flowers, vegetables, roses anything that grows in the ground! This late August-September feeding is the most important feeding of the entire year. K-State and The Green Haus encourage you to apply this application heavy. If you have 5,000 square feet of lawn use 1 and 1/2 bags of fertilizer. If a little bit is good then a whole bunch is better applies today.



Late September-October Fertilome Winterizer

Fertilome Winterizer is the final step to a great lawn. The fertilizer you apply in today will make the turf thicken up this fall which means less room for weeds! This application of fertility is also stored away in the root system of the grass plants giving the turf winter toughness. Fertilizer applied in the fall will green the turf up earlier in the spring with out the extreme flush of grass growth that you get with spring feed turf. Layman terms of that last sentence means less mowing with fall applications compared to spring applications of fertilizer.



October-November Fertilome Weed Free Zone

Fertilome Weed Free Zone will control all broadleaf weeds such as dandelion, henbit and chickweed that try germinate in the fall and then over winter in your yard. K-State horticulture says if you are going to spray one day a year on dandelions do it October 15th. Fall is the best time to control these broadleaf weeds since they are small, young and easy to kill in all types of turf grass including buffalo, bermuda, fescue and bluegrass. Make sure to include *Hi-Yield Spreader Sticker* in your tank mix for better kill of these pesky weeds.
